Ainsworth called the meeting to order at 6:09 p.m. followed by roll call. A quorum was 11 present to conduct business. No adjustments to the agenda. 12 13 **Public Comment** 14 No members of the public present, therefore no public comment. 15 16 Approval of Minutes 01/25/24 K. Millman motioned to approve 01/25/24 minutes. K. Valenta seconded. M. Inners abstained. 17 18 Motion carried. 19 20 **Treasurer's Report** 21 B. Lewis shared the treasurer's report from the last quarter via shared screen and explained the 22 report to the board. B. Lewis provided an explanation of the balance sheet, budget vs. actual, as 23 well as the profit and loss sheet for the quarter and year to date. B. Lewis also showed the board 24 the newly developed financial summary sheets which provide a more concise explanation of the 25 funds. 26 27 C. Ainsworth noted that the new financial summary sheet is helpful and a nice addition to the 28 financial statements. 29 30 G. Rice motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report. E. Grims seconded. Motion carried. 31 32 Policy and Procedure Amendments (action needed) 33 C. Ainsworth explained the policy and procedure documents that were in the board packet for the 34 board members to review. Included were, Delegation of Authority, increase in pay policy 35 addendum for NWFX personnel policy and an attendance bylaw addendum. All documents have 36 been previously adopted by the board; the changes that have been made reflect the new 37 operational structure of staff, and an addendum recommended by our audit last year. 38 39 C. Benjamin confirmed that the Executive Committee has already reviewed the three proposed 40 amendments and we are now seeking board approval. 41 42 A brief discussion took place regarding the documents and relating to board meeting attendance. 43 44 B. Churchill motioned to adopt the three policy and procedure amendments. A. Adams seconded. 45 Motion carried. 46

C. Ainsworth recommended forwarding any suggestions to Chasidy that the board might have to engage selectboards. The Executive Committee can discuss utilizing any suggested methods in the future.

K. Millman confirmed that it is the responsibility of the Governing Board representatives to communicate with the selectboards, not NWFX staff's responsibility to contact selectboards with updates.

K. Valenta asked how we are addressing vacancies. C. Ainsworth answered that she is planning on calling the selectboards to discuss any vacancies and that addressing this has been an ongoing discussion with the Executive Committee.

A. Adams stated to let NRPC know if they can help in any way to send out notification of vacancies, as they have done this with other boards in the past.

C. Benjamin Reported:

- NWFX annual meeting for board elections will be held Tuesday May 14th at 6pm.
- If you have any questions on if you have been reappointed by your town, please feel free to reach out, these appointments are due April 29th.
- We have ordered the essentials for the office in Fairfield. We've gotten some secondhand deals and donations as well. If anyone has any art they would like to hang in our office, or if the board knows of any local artists that would want to donate please let staff know.
- NWFX staff have been involved in VCUDA's Digital Equity Coalition. The group is in its
 infancy, but it is focusing on trying to mobilize resources statewide for private and public
 sector partners to apply for NTIA's Digital Equity Competitive Grant. They want to ensure
 they approach each district to see who each CUD believes to be a key changemaker and
 best suited for this.

M.K. Raymond Reported via shared screen:

• NWFX was awarded the BEAD Subrecipient Grant for \$150,000 which helps us gather all our information and data to apply for BEAD. Once we receive the funds, we will get an RFP out to help us write our BEAD application.

• We are tentatively presenting on April 29th to the VCBB Board for our ARPA Grant Application.

 We have completed a revision of our business plan and financial model for the VCBB staff and third party (CTC) to review this week for their approval.
