Burdick called the meeting to order at 12:39pm, a roll call was conducted, and a quorum was 12 present to conduct business. There were no adjustments to the agenda. 13 14 **Public Comment** 15 No members of the public present, therefore no public comment. 16 17 Approval of Minutes 10/13/23 18 Z. Burdick motioned to approve 10/13/23 minutes. K. Millman seconded. Motion carried. 19 20 **Review Proposed Budget (executive session)** 21 Z. Burdick motioned to enter Executive Session including NWFX Staff to review further Proposed Budget 22 details whereas premature general public knowledge regarding the related Review of Proposed Budget 23 details would clearly place the public body, or a person involved at a substantial disadvantage. K. Millman seconded. Motion carried. 24 25 26 Z. Burdick reported that the group had a discussion regarding and reviewing the Proposed Budget but 27 noted that no action was taken in Executive Session other than to end Executive Session. 28 29 **Policy Considerations** 30 S. Kio reminded the committee that upon receipt of our audit results we were advised to adopt a few 31 additional policies to secure our financial wellbeing. S. Kio shared the draft Financial Management 32 Policy, Fraud Policy, and the Financial Controls Memo via shared screen. S. Kio explained each 33 document and stated that the policies, as well as the suggested amendment to the Personnel Policy, will 34 need to go before the Governing Board for approval. S. Kio will send all of the shared documents to the 35 Executive Committee for notes and corrections. 36 37 **Other Business** 38 S. Kio stated that we are trying to establish vision insurance for NWFX staff in 2024. We are able to do 39 this by going through one of the companies we currently use for life and disability insurance. Currently 40 only the two full time employees are offered life and disability insurance, however we were informed 41 after starting the vision insurance process that all three employees would have to enroll in the life and 42 disability insurance to be eligible for the vision insurance. S. Kio stated that it is a very small impact on 43 the yearly budget, and we do have enough margin in the budget to include this. The Chairman as well as 44 the rest of the committee agreed this would be acceptable to offer these benefits to all three 45 employees, including the part time employee. 46
