Kio shared the treasurer's report from the last quarter via shared screen and B. Lewis explained the 21 report to the board. B. Lewis provided an explanation of the balance sheet as well as the profit and loss 22 sheet for the month of March 2023 and for the quarter. 23 24 S. Mitchell motioned to accept the Treasurer's Report. E. Grims seconded. Motion carried. 25 26 ISP Update (executive session) 27 K. Millman motioned to include NWFX and NRPC Staff in Executive Session. J. Kane seconded. Motion 28 Carried. 29 30 B. Churchill motioned to enter Executive Session including NWFX and NRPC Staff to discuss ISP Update 31 details whereas premature general public knowledge regarding the related ISP Updates would clearly 32 place the public body, or a person involved at a substantial disadvantage. S. McGowan seconded. 33 Motion carried. 34 35 C. Ainsworth reported that the group discussed the ISP Update but noted that no action was taken in 36 Executive Session other than to end Executive Session. 37 38 **Executive Director Report** 39 S. Kio Reported: 40 41 Staff are working on developing a live dashboard for board members to view progress as well as 42 reworking the monthly executive director's report. 43 VCBB is continuing to work on BEAD letter of credit waivers. 44 VCBB hired general counsel and still has two other open positions posted on their website. 45 VCUDA is paying close attention to three bills that are trying to be passed. 46 Northern Boarders released a grant called the catalyst program. NWFX Executive Committee

discussed this and chose not to apply this year.

- NWFX completed our Telco Insurance Audit.
  - NWFX staff are having ongoing meetings with our ISP partner and working on an MSA.
  - We have had to resubmit our registration with sam.gov several times, as we need this in order to receive our grant funds. We are having difficulty changing our address.
  - S. Kio has reached out to K. Millman (Alburgh Rep) to develop an outreach and awareness plan for the rest of 2023. Once this is put together, we will let the board know so this can be reviewed in a workgroup.
  - Our grant reporting continues to be done on time. Our grant amendment has been approved but we are still waiting for our sam.gov approval before we can draw down funds.
  - NRTC has completed High Level Design and NWFX staff is reviewing. MK is working on getting
    the import data to import directly into our fiber mapping software. Our ongoing relationship
    with NRTC is pending with our current ISP partner.
  - MK flew to Oklahoma and completed a train the trainer course. She is now one of the only people in the state that is certified to teach this.
  - Representative appointments are due from communities on April 24<sup>th</sup> to serve on the NWFX governing board. Chasidy has been reaching out to communities weekly to get these submitted.
  - There is a recorded session on YouTube to review the Vermont Open Meeting Law but if new board members are interested, we can get a live session with NRPC. Hearing no interest in the live session from new board members, we will send the link for the video training via email.
  - May 9<sup>th</sup> will be our board elections.
  - May 17<sup>th</sup> at 11am we have scheduled our newcomers and staff Q&A.
