32 33	and the board to adopt the budget. Taking these timelines into consideration, we are putting forward our best estimate with NRTC's assumptions and seeking approval of the budget from the board. Once
33 34	we have a more accurate estimate of these costs, we will likely need to propose an amendment to the
35	adopted budget in 2024 to be approved by the board. S. Kio continued to provide an explanation of the
36	line items for the remainder of the budget.
